



National Biodiversity Park, Visakhapatnam, is a Botanical garden, an ex situ conservation park, first of its kind in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh, India. The park is located in the premises of the Rani Chandramati Devi Government Hospital. It extends over 3 acres (1.2 ha). National Biodiversity Park can be highly educational and contribute to a deeper understanding of


