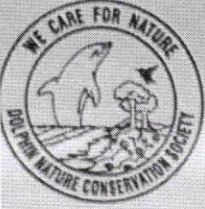



VISIT TO NATIONAL BIODIVERSITY PARK VISAKHAPATNAM

DATE: 25/7/22

National Biodiversity Park, Visakhapatnam, is a Botanical garden, an *ex situ* conservation park, first of its kind in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh, India. The park is located in the premises of the Rani Chandramati Devi Government Hospital. It extends over 3 acres (1.2 ha). Dolphin Nature Conservation Society (DNCS), Visakhapatnam, a registered, eco-friendly, non-government Organization has maintained it for 13 years and is now maintaining it in collaboration with the hospital and Visakhapatnam Metropolitan Region Development Authority. The park was inaugurated on 5 June 2002. This park has more than 2,000 species of plants and has recorded visits by 60 species of birds and 105 species of butterflies. The park has become a "living laboratory" for education, awareness and research for students, and botanists, zoologists and researchers.,

B.Pharm students of Viswanadha Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences , Sontyam, Visakhapatnam, under the guidance of Dr P Umadevi and under the supervision of Staff

members Dr B Nagamani, Ms.I vasavi, Ms R Indu, Ms. D Pavitra, Ms. N Hemalatha and Mr K Srinu visited the Biodiversity park.

We were puzzled to see vast varieties of Medicinal plants , Sacred Groves, Living Fossil plants of Jurassic times (Gymnosperms), Cacti and Succulents, Ornamental Plants, Aquatic Plants, and Aromatic Plants and Insectivorous Plants.

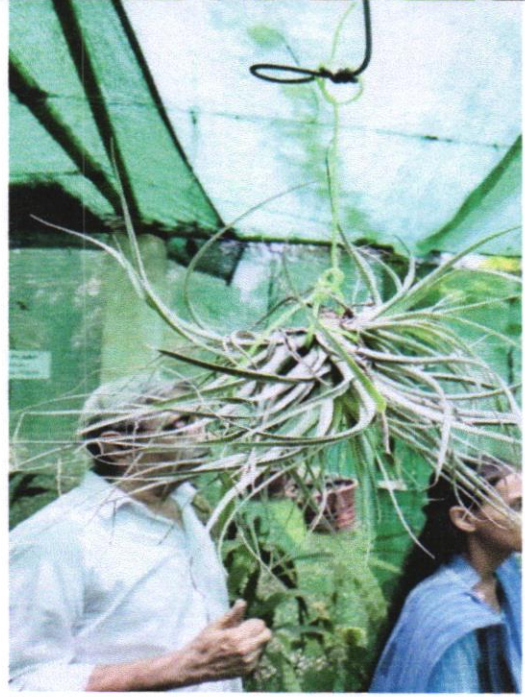

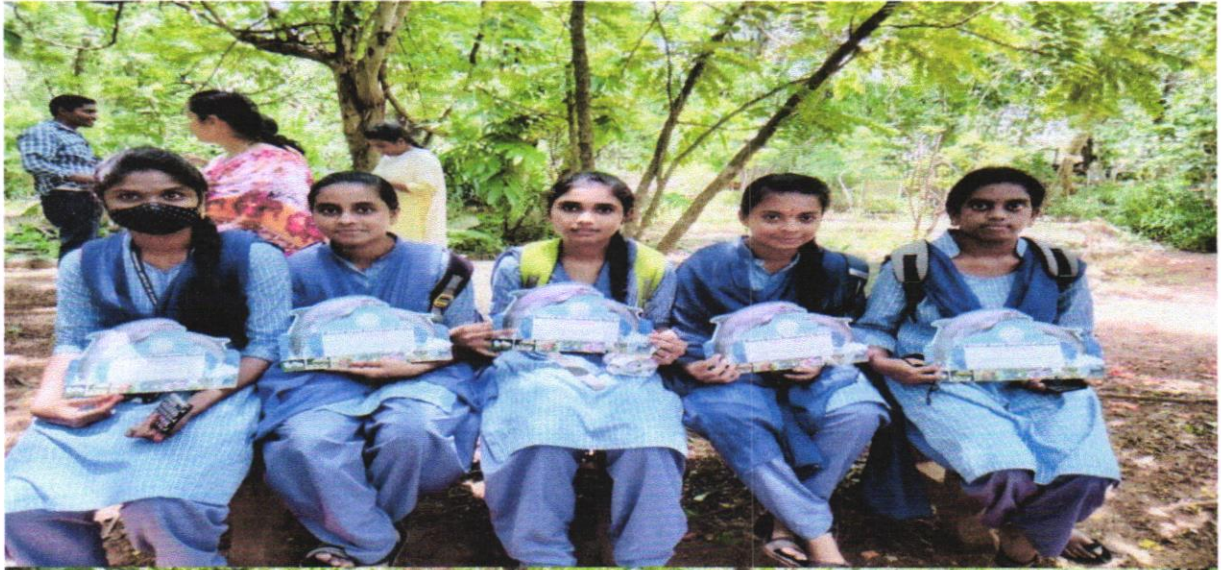












Membership certificate Distribution
