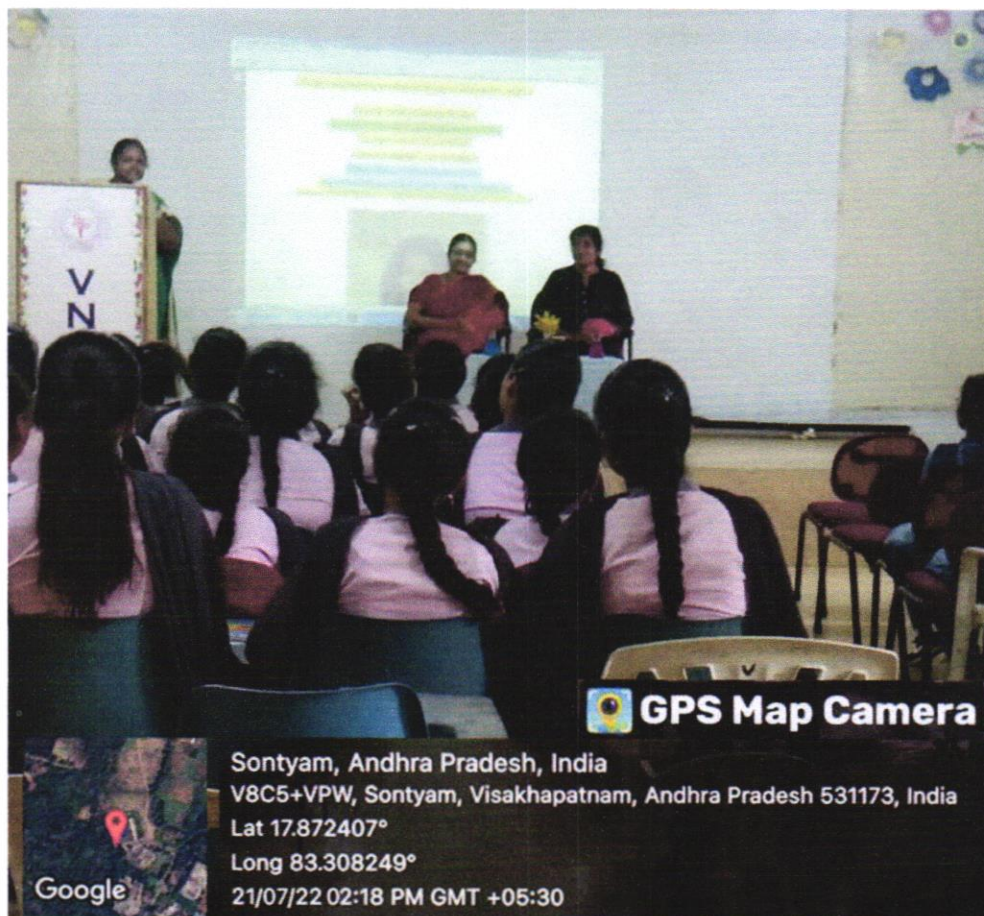

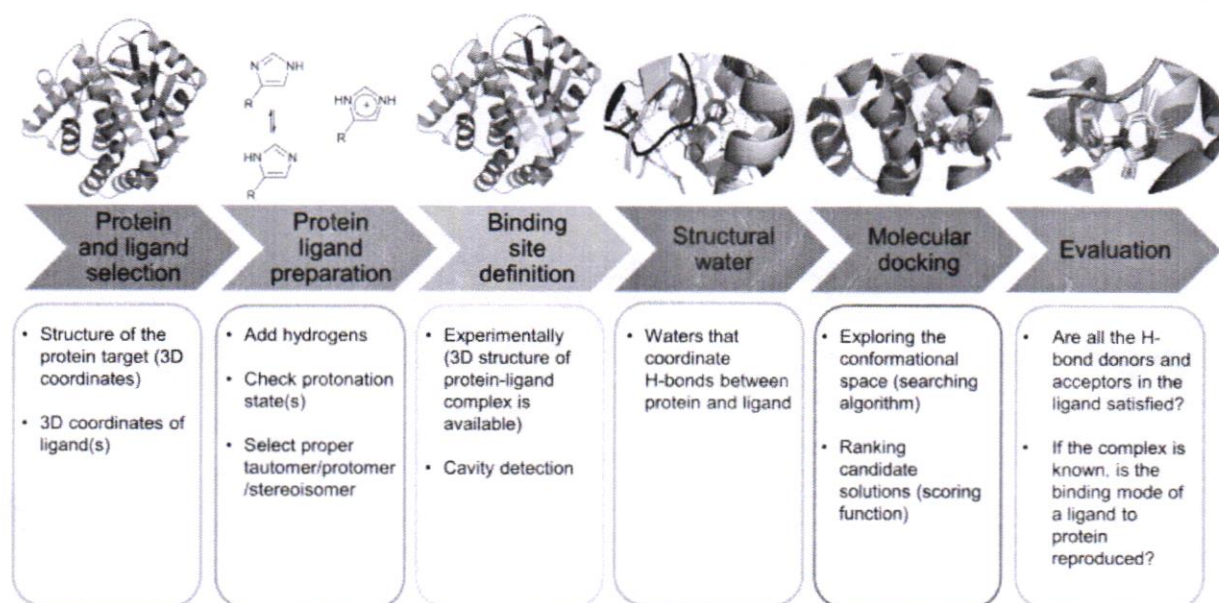
Topics covered:

Drug-Like Properties: Drug-likeness is a qualitative, intrinsic and distinctive property of chemical substances that influences the behavior of molecule and plays an important role in determining their therapeutic efficacy.

ADMET Properties: Pharmacokinetic and toxicological parameters such as absorption, distribution, metabolism, excretion and toxicity of the top interacted ligands were predicted by using various online servers available freely.

Bioactivity Scores: Bioactivity score was another computational method for determining the similarity of molecular properties and structural characteristics of any new compound with known drugs.

Molecular docking studies: Molecular docking is a method for analyzing the conformation and orientation of molecules in a macromolecular biological target's binding site. Poses are generated by search algorithms and ranked using scoring functions.



Outcome:

The students were aware about that molecular docking studies can be useful to predict the binding affinity of any compound and the biological target protein and play a significant role in finding an inhibitor through structure-based drug design.

2. Utility Patents are relatively short-term rights granted for inventions that can be mechanical, electrical, or chemical in nature, and they protect the invention in the way in which it is used.
3. Marginal or minimal improvement is acceptable for the grant of utility model patents.
