

Objectives of the program:

The program's most important objective is to aware students about the importance of structure activity relationship in drug development and to understand about the compounds with similar structures to a pharmacologically active drug.

Topics covered:

Structure activity relationship is used to develop a new drug that has increased activity, a different activity from an existing drug and fewer unwanted effects. It is typically possible to infer a novel chemical compound's biological effects from its molecular structure by utilizing information about other compounds that are comparable to it.

The effect of structural changes on biological activity:

- 1. Modifying the size and shape of the molecule
- 2. Introduction of new substituent's
- 3. Introduction of a group in an un-substituted position
