1. Purpose and Objectives:



Preamble:

VNIPS is a 9 year old premier and reputed institution in academics and research, approved by Pharmacy Council of India under Section 12 & AICTE and affiliated to JNTUK, an institution of Viswanadha Educational Society which is also successfully running VITAM (Engineering & MBA) and Delhi Public School, Anandapuram.

Whereas GVPIHCMT 4 years old, 300 bedded premier teaching hospital in Visakhapatnam supplying healthcare services to North Coastal Andhra Pradesh and to Orissa and is having many specialized services such as STD, outpatient block, clinical laboratory block, pediatric block in addition to the traditional medical services.

Both VNIPS and GVPIHCMT are convinced about the mutual benefit of forging a formal synergistic linkage to develop new collaborative teaching and research program in the areas of pharmacy practice and allied health care fields. Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants hereinafter contained the parties agree as follows:

Scope of work and responsibilities:

The two parties after considering their objectives and strengths have agreed to have an understanding for collaboration in the following areas of interest.

- Organizing and participating in joint symposia/conferences/workshops/short term refresher courses.
- Carrying out interdisciplinary research.
- Exchange of faculty for guest lectures as well as examiner ships.
- Medicinal and pharmaceutical consultancy services of mutual interest.
- Extending access to library and knowledge sharing facilities mutually for both students and faculty.
- Providing clinical training or internship or residency training to the students of Pharm D and / or Pharm D Post Baccalaureate during their course of study.
 This will consist of the following:
- Every Pharm D student of VNIPS will be posted in GVPIHCMT for a period of not less than fifty hours to be covered in not less than 200 working days in each of second, third and fourth year courses.
- Every fifth year Pharm D student of VNIPS will spend half a day in the morning hours attending ward rounds in daily basis in GVPIHCMT.
- Every sixth year Pharm D student of VNIPS will be given internship or residency training for one year by GVPIHCMT during which period the student will provide clinical pharmacy services to the allotted wards. His / her services will be in the general medicine department for six months and in three other specialty departments for another six months (2 months in each department).

• In all the above referred to programmes the Pharm D students and Pharm D (Post baccalaureate) students of VNIPS will attend to the allotted duties/training programmes in a punctual manner and disciplined manner and under the supervision of the college.

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- In the period of training the Pharm D students and Pharm D (Post baccalaureate students) students are expected to participate in activities like drug storage of medicines, dispensing procedures to inpatients, drug information, and therapeutic drug monitoring, reporting of adverse drug reactions and understanding Pharmaco economics. They are also expected to participate in clinical research and carry out their research projects in GVPIHCMT.
- In the process of this training the students of Pharm D, in co-operation with patients, prescribers and other members of an inter-professional health care team learn to
 - Participate in patient care and in clinical pharmacy services
 - Learn to manage the resources of health care system to promote health and
 - To develop leadership skills and communication skills
 - Duration: This memorandum of understanding shall be valid for a period of 8
 years from the date of signing of the same and thereafter can be renewed for a
 further period as may be mutually agreed upon.
 - Modification: No modification to this memorandum of understanding shall be binding unless made in writing and signed by both parties.
 - Facilities: GVPIHCMT will extend some facilities to the staff and students of VNIPS such that the clinical pharmacy services can be most effectively provided by them and the students can learn effectively and therapeutic monitoring services can be supplied by VNIPS which will enhance the patient care to very high level. To facilitate effective pursuit of clinical pharmacy services, VNIPS will be given access to additional space for carrying outpatient counseling on OP wing, a class room that can accommodate 30 students, a laboratory where a batch of 20 students can work, a room where five faculty members can sit and a room where advanced analytical equipment like HPLC, freezer, cooling centrifuge and UV Spectrophotometer can be kept that can made into an AC room. VNIPS will be responsible for the electricity bills and other contingency expenditure in the rooms where clinical pharmacy activity is carried out.

Clinical Attachment Fee (For II, III, IV and V year only):

The College shall have to pay prescribed Clinical Attachment fee for the period above six months @ 2500/- per student for one academic year.

Internship Fee (For VI year only):

Each internee shall have to pay of $Rs\ 25,000$ /- in lump sum for doing internship before the start of internship for the entire duration.

The following Rules will be observed in the hospital during clinical attachment:

- Teacher or Teaching Associate who accompanies the students' batch will be responsible for the conduct and behavior of the students holding appointments or attending the wards or the departments.
- 2. All students while on duty in the hospital are under the control of the RMO and their Teacher/Teaching Associate, Students desirous of an interview with the Superintendent should apply to the Teacher/Teaching Associate/RMO.
- No student except those on duty may be present in the hospital premises beyond 4.00 PM under any circumstances whatever except with the written permission of the Resident Medical Officer.
- 4. The following are the ordinary duty hours of the hospital:
 - a. Outpatient:- 9 to12.00 Noon
 - b. In-Patent :- 10 AM to 12.30 PM and 2 to 4.00 PM
- 5. All students are required to equip themselves with their own appliances
- 6. Students will be required to pay for any hospital appliances which may be broken or destroyed through their carelessness/handling.
- 7. Students must never forget that they are working in a hospital and that the patients given into their charge are sick requiring kind and thoughtful attention. What has been said clinically regarding a patient is not to be repeated to them or to others by any of the students attending classes.
- Teachers/Teaching Associate accompanying the student is responsible for attendance of students posted to the wards for clinical instruction at 10.00 AM daily.
- 9. Students will not make any entries in the case sheets. They shall have to write their case notes in their clinical observation note books and those notes will be checked and signed by their Teacher/Teaching Associate before getting certificate from Chief of the units. So as to ensure proper clinical training to the students log books should be maintained by every student.
- 10. The postings of students to the wards and departments will be made by the Hospital authorities (RMO) in consultation with professor of Pharmacy to suit their requirements.
- 11. The hospital will prepare for the VI years "Assessment card for internship programme". For undergoing internship for one year, during which period the student will provide clinical pharmacy services to the allotted wards, the following schedule will be adopted.

Students admitted for clinical training/internship must conform to the rules and regulations of the hospital and should behave properly with the hospital staff and authorities and with their colleagues and any misconduct by a student will be dealt with by immediate discharge of the concerned student from the training
- 13. Students will assist in the bio-medical waste management in the hospital premises.
- 14. They should be properly identified in their dress code with name and course
- 15. The students should also behave in a kind manner with the patients. Any complaint from the patients will be viewed seriously.
- 16. Group gossips among students should be avoided.
- 17. There should be no clash with the regular MBBS, PG student's bedside clinical teachings. As far as possible bedside clinical training/ Teaching be not overlapped during rush hours or in morning hours.


